

## **B and B Training Stables Rules:**

1. Shoes or boots with a hard toe and heel must be worn. (No Tennis Shoes)
2. Helmets are required. We have a few but recommend you purchase your own.
3. Long Pants, no shorts.
4. Arrive at least 15 minutes early to groom, tack and prepare your horse unless this is part of your lesson.
5. Lessons start promptly at the specified time, if you are late this will cut time off your lesson.
6. 24 hour notice is required to cancel lessons, if 24 hour notice is not given, you will be charged for the lesson. If it is an emergency, family illness, injury etc., please notify us ASAP and you will not be charged. If you do not call and do not show, you will be warned once and the second time you will be dropped from the program.
7. Allow time after the lesson to care for the horse and tack. This means cool down, hosing, put away, grooming etc. This does not mean hanging out for 2 hours without a specific purpose.
8. No running.
9. Parents are encouraged to watch but not instruct, please be considerate in that the facility is a private residence and not a public stable. Persons causing a disruption to the general quiet and peacefulness of the facility will be asked to leave.
10. Call ahead if weather is questionable. Typically lessons will be cancelled if it is storming or over 95 degrees. Please keep the heat in mind when scheduling your lessons.
11. All payments are non-refundable and must be used within 4 weeks of payment, including make-ups. Consideration will be made in the even of family emergency situations or rider being injured in some form.
12. The instructor reserves the right to limit the lesson time due to lack of concentration, weather or stamina.
13. No feeding treats to horses unless you have the specific permission from that owner for that horse.
14. Pick up after yourself. This means both personal trash and the grooming area/wash stall used by your horse.
15. Respect people's space. This means both them and their horse. Unless you are actively involved with that person, please leave them, their stuff and horse alone.

Rule infractions will be dealt with as such unless otherwise noted:

- 1<sup>st</sup> offense – Verbal Warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup> offense – Written Warning outlining behavior and ways to improve.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> offense – Removal from the program.

If the person is deemed to be a danger to themselves or others due to their behavior we reserve the right to expel them from the program immediately!

By signing the bottom of this page, you understand the rules and agree to comply at all times to the rules for the betterment of yourself, the facility and the horses. Those under 18 must have their parent or guardian sign as well as themselves to show acknowledgement.
